


Countries covered in articles published in sampled issues of IJPP from 1996 until 2009 (71 articles)


Countries covered in articles published in sampled issues of IJPP from 2010 until 2020 (66 articles)


Country of residence of lead author of all manuscripts submitted to IJPP, 2007-2020 (2,344 manuscripts)


Country of residence of lead author of all manuscripts published in IJPP, 2007-2020 (394 manuscripts)
